

Some items may only be **Carried on the Person.**

These include:

Safety Matches
and
Cigarette Lighters



Certain **Dangerous Goods** are allowed to be carried in **Hand Baggage**.

These include **Alcoholic Beverages** (not more than 70% alcohol by volume), **Spare/Loose Batteries** (Lithium Metal, Lithium Ion and Non-Lithium), **E-Cigarettes** (Including e-cigars, e-pipes and other personal vaporizers), **Portable Electronic Devices containing Lithium Batteries** (Including laptop computers, electronic tablets and mobile telephones) and **Toiletry Items containing Dangerous Goods** (Including perfumes, nail polish and remover, hairspray, shaving creams, insect repellents etc—but only in containers and quantities of 100ml or less)

Certain **Dangerous Goods** are allowed to be carried in **Hold Baggage**.

These are very similar to those items which are allowed to be carried in **Hand Baggage** and include **Alcoholic Beverages** (not more than 70% alcohol by volume), **Portable Electronic Devices containing Lithium Batteries** (Including laptop computers, electronic tablets and mobile telephones) and **Toiletry Items containing Dangerous Goods** (Including perfumes, nail polish and remover, hairspray, shaving creams, insect repellents etc—for personal use).

Some other items may also be carried in **Hold Baggage** with **Approval from the Operator** these include **Heat-Producing Articles** (such as Diving Lamps and Soldering Irons) and **Camping Stoves with Fuel Containers** (Fuel containers must be empty)



Loose and Spare Lithium Ion and Lithium Metal batteries must be carried in hand baggage.

Non-Lithium loose batteries must also be carried in hand baggage



There are many categories of **Dangerous Goods:**

EXPLOSIVES, FLAMMABLE GASES, FLAMMABLE LIQUIDS, FLAMMABLE SOLIDS, OXIDIZING SUBSTANCES, ORGANIC PEROXIDES, TOXIC SUBSTANCES, INFECTIOUS SUBSTANCES AND CORROSIVES

Some are completely **Forbidden** for Air Transport, many can be shipped as **Cargo** in accordance with the **Regulations**, some items can be carried in your **Baggage**, however there are many items that you **Must Not Carry** in your baggage or on your person when you travel:

FIREWORKS SPRAY PAINT
INSECT SPRAY BUTANE GAS
ALCOHOLS > 70% BY VOLUME
PROPANE GAS PETROL
LIGHTER FLUID SOLVENTS
STRIKE-ANYWHERE MATCHES
ACIDS FIRE-LIGHTERS

This leaflet does not contain a full and comprehensive list of all dangerous goods that are allowed in passenger baggage, nor does it provide a complete list of those items of dangerous goods which are forbidden from being carried by passengers.

Carriage of all Dangerous Goods is at the discretion of the airline
