



AIR NAVIGATION (OVERSEAS TERRITORIES) ORDER 2013

DIRECTION

Pursuant to a designation by His Excellency the Governor and in accordance with Article 68(1) of the Air Navigation (Overseas Territories) Order 2013 (AN(OT)O), the Director of Civil Aviation issues the following **DIRECTION** prohibiting the use of all Small Unmanned Aircraft within the area of the Argentine Cemetery near Darwin.

IT IS DIRECTED THAT:

Small unmanned aircraft must not be operated at any height within an area of the Argentine Cemetery near Darwin, joining the following successive points:



South 51° 47' 38" West 58° 56' 38"

South 51° 47' 38" West 58° 56' 7"

South 51° 47' 58" West 58° 56' 38"

South 51° 47' 58" West 58° 56' 7"

TAKE NOTE:

It is a criminal offence to contravene terms of this Direction.

INFORMATION:

Small Unmanned Aircraft (SUA) are also commonly referred to as drones, quadcopters, small unmanned surveillance aircraft and unmanned aerial vehicles, etc.

A person who needs to fly a SUA contrary to this Direction must obtain written permission from the Director of Civil Aviation and must operate in accordance with the AN(OT)O.

This Direction is issued, in addition to the existing Regulations that apply to SUA operations.

This Direction shall have effect from the 17th of August 2021 – the 30th of September 2021 unless varied or cancelled.
